

NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AEP Ohio Transmission Company representatives plan power upgrades to support the electric service needs of an AEP customer, Fox Squirrel Solar, LLC. in Oak Run Township, Madison County.

The Chenoweth Station and Chenoweth-Fox Squirrel 345 kV Tie Line Project constructs Chenoweth Substation off Johnston Road in Oak Run Township and .1 miles of 345-kilovolt (kV) power line to provide redundant electrical service to the customer's substation.

AEP Ohio Transmission Company representatives filed a Letter of Notification with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) as the Chenoweth Station and Chenoweth-Fox Squirrel 345 kV Tie Line Project, Case No. Case No. 22-0955-EL-BLN. The Letter of Notification to construct, operate and maintain this facility awaits OPSB review. If approved, construction begins in January and concludes by September.

The OPSB accepts motions to intervene in the Letter of Notification up to 10 days following the publication of this notice. The requirements to intervene are included in Rule 4906-2-12 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Please address motions to the Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 E. Broad St., Columbus, Ohio, 43215-3793 and cite Case No. 22-0955-EL-BLN.


