NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AEP Ohio representatives plan transmission line upgrades in Licking County.

AEP Ohio representatives announced plans in summer 2020 to rebuild about 32 miles of 138-kilovolt (kV) transmission line, connecting the North Newark, Newark Center and Crooksville substations in Perry, Muskingum and Licking counties. There have been several outages on the power line in the past five years due to deteriorating equipment. Replacing wooden H-frames from the 1950s and 1960s with steel H-frames reduces larger, sustained community outages and strengthens the local electric system.


As the project continues to develop, AEP Ohio representatives filed another Letter of Notification with additional revisions to the line. Crews need to realign .43 miles of the power line due to foundation issues discovered during construction.

If approved, company representatives expect construction to begin early next year and conclude end of 2024.

The OPSB accepts motions to intervene in the Letter of Notification up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice. The requirements to intervene can befound in Rule 4906-2-12 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Please address motions to Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 E.
