

NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AEP Ohio Officials Propose An Electrical Transmission Line Project In Licking County.

AEP Ohio representatives propose a transmission line project in the city of New Albany and Jersey Township, Licking County.

The project involves:

- Building Curleys 345-kilovolt (kV) Station at the intersection of Johnstown Utica Road and Tippet Road.
- Building four transmission lines from the existing Conesville-Corridor 345 kV Transmission Line off Johnstown Utica Road to Curleys Station.
- Building two double-circuit transmission lines from Curleys Station to the customer station.

AEP Ohio officials previously filed Curleys 138 kV Temporary Transmission Line Project, Case No. 26-0171-EL-BLN, a temporary solution with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB), to support a customer's early construction. Curleys Substation and associated transmission lines provide a permanent solution to provide electric service to a customer's development in the area.

AEP Ohio officials filed the following permanent project components with the OPSB:

- Letter of Notification:** Curleys 345 kV Station Project, Case No. 26-0351-EL-BLN. This project involves building Curleys Station at the intersection of Johnstown Utica Road and Tippet Road.
- Construction Notification:** Conesville-Corridor 345 kV Transmission Line Cut-In and Curleys-Numenor 345 kV Transmission Tie-Lines Project, Case No. No. 26-0352-EL-BNR. This project includes building four transmission lines from the existing Conesville-Corridor 345 kV Transmission Line off Johnstown Utica Road to Curleys Substation and building two double-circuit transmission lines from Curleys Station to the OPSB approved customer station.

The Letter of Notification and Construction Notice to construct, operate and maintain these facilities await OPSB review. If approved, company officials expect construction on the project to begin in the summer and conclude early next year.

The OPSB accepts motions to intervene in the Letter of Notification and Construction Notice up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice. The requirements to intervene are included in Rule 4906-2-12 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Please address motions to Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 E.
