NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AEP Ohio officials have proposed a transmission project in Elk Township, Vinton County.

AEP Ohio representatives plan to adjust 0.2 miles of 138-kilovolt (kV) transmission line to accommodate the expansion of Elk Station, located off Morgan Road between Barleon Road and U.S. Highway 50, in Elk Township, Vinton County. The company needs to adjust the line to interconnect a solar facility customer into the power grid. If approved, company officials expect construction to begin spring 2024 and conclude by late 2024.

AEP Ohio representatives have filed a Letter of Notification with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) as the Elk Extension North 138 kV Line Adjustment Project, Case. No. 23-0985-EL-BLN. The Letter of Notification to construct, operate and maintain this facility awaits OPSB review. The OPSB accepts motions to intervene in the Letter of Notification up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice.


