

Delphos Area Transmission Line Rebuilds Project

AEP Ohio representatives plan power grid upgrades in Allen, Putnam and Van Wert counties. The project strengthens the local electric system by replacing aging equipment with modern facilities.

What

The project involves:

- Rebuilding about 9 miles of 69-kilovolt transmission line between 4 area substations.
- Replacing deteriorating wooden poles from the 1930s with modern steel poles.

Why

The improvements:

- Reduce the need for frequent power line maintenance due to aging equipment.
- Rebuild the transmission lines to improve operational performance.
- Reduce the likelihood of extended power outages and enhance electric reliability for area customers.


Where

The project area involves:

- Allen County: Marion Township
- Putnam County: Jennings Township
- Van Wert County: Washington Township

Company representatives plan to rebuild a majority of the line in or near its current location. The project may require updating or supplementing existing easements in select areas. Easements are defined land rights that provide the utility with access needed to safely build, operate and maintain its power lines.

Project Schedule





— Transmission Line to be Rebuilt


▲ Existing Substation
