

NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AEP Ohio officials have proposed adjustments to an electric transmission line project in Delaware and Licking counties.

AEP Ohio representatives plan to build two 13-mile 345-kilovolt (kV) transmission lines between the existing Vassell Substation in Sunbury, Delaware County and the proposed Green Chapel Substation in New Albany, Licking County. The improvements connect new customers to the electric grid and ensure continued reliable electricity for area customers. If approved, company officials expect construction to begin early 2025 and conclude spring 2027.

As the project continues to develop, AEP Ohio representatives are proposing minor route adjustments to the previously filed Vassell-Green Chapel 345 kV Transmission Line Project, Case No. 24-0014-EL-BLN. Company representatives have filed a Letter of Notification with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) for the recent route adjustments as the Vassell-Green Chapel 345 kV Transmission Line Adjustments #2 Project, Public Utilities Commission of Ohio Case No. 24-1043-EL-BLN.

The Letter of Notification to construct, operate and maintain this facility awaits OPSB review. The OPSB accepts motions to intervene in the Letter of Notification up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice. The requirements to intervene are included in Rule 4906-2-12 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Please address motions to Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 E.
