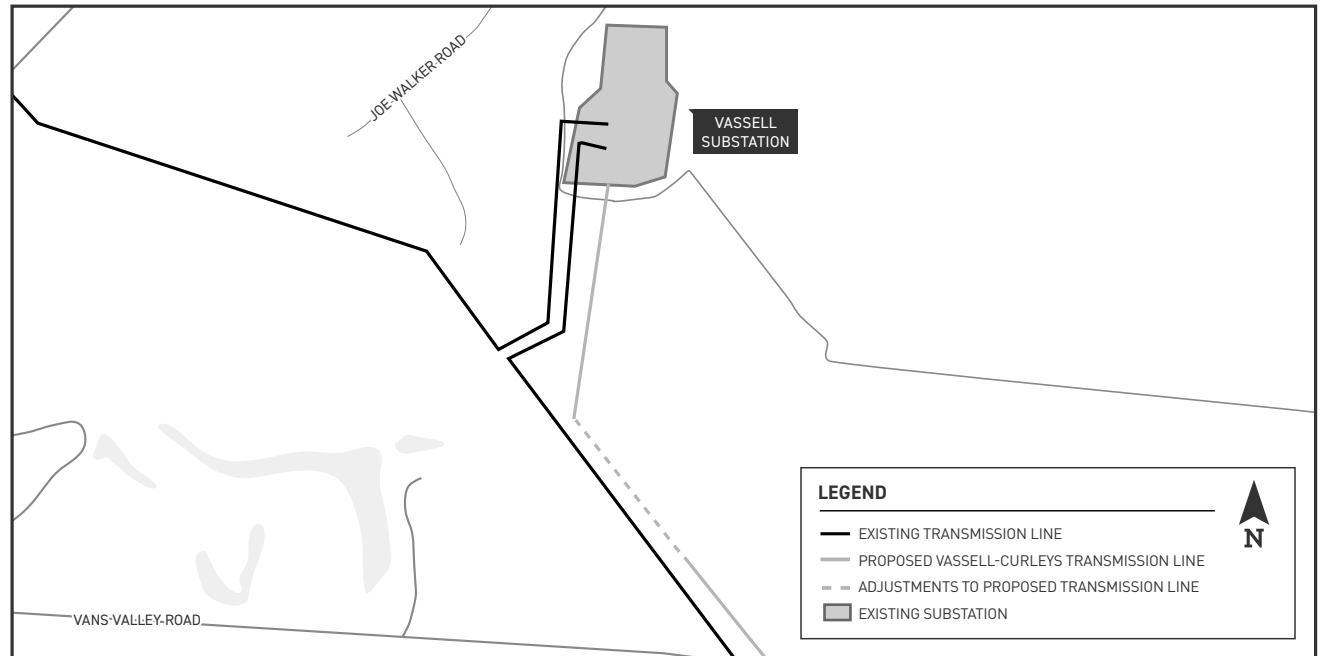


NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AEP Ohio officials have proposed adjustments to an electric transmission line project in Delaware and Licking counties.

AEP Ohio representatives plan to build two 13-mile 345-kilovolt (kV) transmission lines connecting Vassell Substation off State Route 37 in Sunbury to two new substations off Green Chapel Road in New Albany. Company representatives announced the Vassell-Green Chapel Transmission Enhancements project in December 2023 and the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) approved the power line between Vassell and Curleys substations in June 2024. Construction on this line began in early 2026 and concludes in spring 2027.

As the project progresses, AEP Ohio representatives plan to adjust 0.25 miles of the transmission line between the existing Vassell 345 kV Station and Vans Valley Road, due to its proximity to an existing underground gas pipeline. Company representatives filed a Letter of Notification with OPSB for the adjustments as the Vassell-Curleys 345 kV Transmission Line Adjustment #3 Project, Case No. 26-0433-EL-BLN.



This filing follows three previously approved Letters of Notification under Case No. 24-0118-EL-BLN, Case No. 24-0792-EL-BLN, and Case No. 25-0225-EL-BLN.

The Letter of Notification to construct, operate and maintain this facility awaits OPSB review. The OPSB accepts motions to intervene in the Letter of Notification up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice. The requirements to intervene are included in Rule 4906-2-12 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Please address motions to Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 E.
