AEP Ohio officials have proposed an electric transmission project in city of Whitehall, Mifflin and Truro townships, Franklin County, Ohio.

AEP Ohio representatives plan to build two 138-kilovolt (kV) transmission line extensions, totaling approximately 0.2 miles from the proposed Poth Station, located off Poth Road between Schofield Drive and Hyland Court, to the existing East Broad Street - Bexley 138-kV transmission line on Poth Road in the city of Whitehall. Franklin County. The company needs to build the transmission line extensions to meet Whitehall and surrounding areas' growing electrical load demand. Crews also plan to remove 0.1 miles of the East Broad Street - Bexley 138-kV transmission line and replace two structures to accommodate the new transmission line extensions.


