

# NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AEP Ohio representatives announced the Jordan Substation Project in fall 2025. The project involves building Jordan Substation near the intersection of Clover Valley Road and Mink Street in New Albany.

As the project moves forward, company representatives plan to:

- Adjust 0.2 miles of existing 138-kilovolt (kV) transmission line and build two 0.3-mile, 138-kV transmission lines to connect Jordan Substation to the power grid. Officials filed a Letter of Notification for this project component with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) as the Innovation – Brie 138kV Transmission Line Cut-In and Jordan North and South 138kV Transmission Line Extension Project, Case No. 26-0248-EL-BLN.

- Build two 0.1-mile, 138-kV transmission tie lines to provide power to a customer substation. Officials filed a Construction Notice for this project component with OPSB as the Jordan – Jugmink #1 and #2 138kV Transmission Tie Lines Project, Case No. 26-0247-EL-BNR.

The improvements are needed to serve a customer's facility and meet the growing electrical demand in the area. If approved, construction on these project components begins in summer 2026 and concludes late 2026.

The Letter of Notification and Construction Notice to construct, operate and maintain these facilities await OPSB review. The OPSB accepts motions to intervene in the Letter of Notification and Construction Notice for up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice. The requirements to intervene are included in Rule 4906-2-12 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Please address motions to the Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 E.
