

# NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

## AEP Ohio officials have proposed transmission upgrades in Columbus

AEP Ohio representatives plan to relocate 0.3 miles of 138-kilovolt transmission line along Joyce Avenue, between Windsor and Dewey avenues.

Company representatives were asked to shift the location of the power line and structures to make room for a customer's development in the area. Crews plan to rebuild this section of transmission line with modern steel poles.

If approved, construction begins later this year and concludes next spring.

AEP Ohio representatives have filed a Letter of Notification with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) as the Mifflin-St. Clair Avenue 138kV Transmission Line Adjustment Project, Public Utilities Commission of Ohio Case No. 25-0804-EL-BLN.

The Letter of Notification to construct, operate and maintain this facility awaits OPSB review. The OPSB accepts motions to intervene in the Letter of Notification up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice. The requirements to intervene are included in Rule 4906-2-12 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Please address motions to Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 E. Broad St., Columbus, OH, 43215-3793 and cite Case No. 25-0804-EL-BLN.
